All of our highly qualified teachers are trained to provide cross-cultural education and communication. Beside our academic courses, our education involves areas such as music, drama, philanthropic activities, social service, math club, **robotics Club**, sports (soccer, volleyball, track and field, tennis) and other student associations.

Prepa UDEM leads its students to success through a positive learning environment through its 3 main programs:

- 1. Bilingual Program: International students' program of choice; courses are taught in Spanish with English as a Second Language.
- 2. Bicultural Program: Most courses are taught in English, designed to learn about other cultures and languages; international experiences are widely promoted in this program. Additional languages: French and German.
- 3. International Baccalaureate Program: Certified by the IBO, this program develops intellectual, research, analytical and communication skills in the students. 90% of the students obtain an IB Diploma upon graduation.



In close coordination with the Engineering Department at the University, our High School Math Department offers extracurricular courses to prepare our students in the area of robotics and automation. During these courses, they work and participate in the elaboration of automation of prototypes of the German enterprise Fischertechnik, analyzing and testing such prototypes with specialized software in the Engineering Department at the University Campus.

In order to stay updated in the areas of support and exploration robots, every year our teachers and students travel to the facilities of the NASA in Texas. They also organize an annual visit to Disney World in Florida where, through an agreement of cooperation between the Prepa UDEM and the Disney Institute,



our students participate in courses of automation, mathematics and engineering physics where the students work backstage with the same engineers who create the diverse attractions this park offers.

Students and teachers from this course constantly participate in diverse forums and competitions, both at a national and international level, having been recognized recently with the first place at the National FRC Robotics Competition in Mexico.
